MOLMO ONE LANGUAGE PROFILE

SANDAUN PROVINCE, PAPUA NEW GUINEA



The Molmo One (oh-nay) people (aun) live in the mountains of Sandaun Province of Papua New Guinea. Molmo One communities are surrounded by four related language groups (Seta, Kabore One, Inebu One, and Southern One). They have nearby water sources.

Christian Brethren Church, Israel Ministries, PNG Bible Church area. They do have an aid post building (for medical purposes), but there is no one to diagnose patients or dispense medicines. When people are sick, they usually stay in the village and use different remedies found in nature, including papaya and the noni fruit. The closest hospital is a one to two day walk away.


This candle tree is in the Molmo One area. The sap from the candle tree can actually be lit and

burned like a candle. They use the wax as a light source.

In 2015, four Molmo One speakers came to Wewak to receive training in the Oral Bible Storytelling (OBS) workshops. People are eagerly listening to the

stories and learning more of what God wants for their lives. As the OBS workshops progress, how will these stories help the Molmo One be a bright candle to show Christ's love to those around them?
